


PPEs Definitions

- Potentially preventable emergency room visit (PPV)
 - Emergency treatment for a condition that could have been, treated or prevented by a physician or other health care provider in a nonemergency setting.
- Potentially preventable readmission (PPR)
 - A return hospitalization within a set time period that might have resulted from problems in the care during a previous hospital stay or from deficiencies in a post-hospital discharge follow-up.
 - *NOTE:* For the report, PPRs are expressed as PPR chains (one or more PPRs within a readmission window).
- Potentially preventable admission (PPA)
 - A hospital admission or a long-term care facility stay that might have been reasonably prevented with adequate access to ambulatory care or health care coordination.


El Paso First HPs PPEs A/E Ratios

El Paso First HPs Cost per PPE








STAR PPR A/E Ratios in El Paso SA



PPR Cost per 1,000 MM STAR and El Paso SA




Cost per PPR STAR and El Paso SA




PPR A/E Ratios

All STAR Plans El Paso SA




PPR Cost per 1,000 MM All STAR Plans El Paso SA



Volume and Cost PPRs in STAR Program by SA




