Form 3071 Individual Election/Cancellation/Updates

On May 29, 2012 the Department of Aging and Disability Services (DADS) posted the revised Form 3071, Individual Election/Cancellation/Updates including instructions, on the DADS website. Effective July 1, 2012, Hospice providers must use the revised Form 3071, dated May 2012, when obtaining an individual's election/cancellation/update to hospice. The form revision clarifies and initiates required changes in language and changes the form title.

The Texas Medicaid and Healthcare Partnership (TMHP) online portal does not reflect the form text changes, however, the changes made to the form do not include the data elements entered into the portal. Providers should continue to complete the data entry of Form 3071 on the portal.
