State supported living centers are located in Abilene, Austin, Brenham, Corpus Christi, Denton, El Paso, Lubbock, Lufkin, Mexia, Richmond, San Angelo and San Antonio. Each facility may be home to 150–600 residents.

When you work at a state supported living center, you gain unique experience, and job satisfaction in an environment that is therapeutic, dignified and safe for those with developmental disabilities.

## Benefits

In addition to the personal rewards that helping others can provide, DADS offers an attractive compensation package that includes many standard benefits. Optional/negotiable benefits are also available.
